We are delighted that you are interested in bringing students to Amesbury School. We will be offering short stay visits of up to two weeks for a limited number of students between 6 and 19 August 2017.

The costs below are indicative and may be subject to change, depending on the total number of students visiting at that time.

- * Students aged 10 and over can stay alone in homestay accommodation. Each student under 10 years old must have a parent or legal guardian accompany and staying with them. Homestay can be organized for both parent and child, or parents can organize their own accommodation while at Amesbury.
- **Activity fee includes transportation and one teacher aid from Amesbury School accompanying the trip, plus entry and experiences. Final activity fee will depend on whether the stay is 1 week or 2 weeks.
- *** Activity fee includes entry into all the student activities. Parents are required to attend all excursion activities to supervise their child. Additional activities while students are attending school can be arranged for parents at extra cost.



Programme



Short-stay visits to Amesbury School can be one or two weeks long, and are timed to coincide with the New Zealand third term, and Chinese school summer holidays. In 2017, we will be accepting a limited number of short stay students between 13 and 26 August.

Students and care-giving parents will be welcomed to the school by traditional Māori pōwhiri, before being buddied up with an Amesbury student. Student time will be divided between hub-based learning in the school and off-site excursions around Wellington city, combining learning in the New Zealand system and getting to know Wellington. This is a perfect chance to "trial" life in New Zealand if you are interested in longer term education opportunities.

Visiting students will learn alongside Amesbury students and experience the diverse educational opportunities available at the school. Our students are equally keen to learn from our visitors, and we actively seek visiting groups who can offer learning opportunities for Amesbury students.

Excursions around Wellington include visits to world class attractions like Te Papa and Zealandia, Wellington Zoo, a farm experience and other activities that typical Kiwi kids love! In school, visiting students will join in learning sessions with Amesbury students, and participate in our arts and sports rotation programs, and experience learning to ride on our bike track.

Caregiving parents accompanying their children will be welcome to attend all the offsite excursions, and seminars about Amesbury School, the New Zealand Education system and the Wellington property market will be arranged while the students are learning. Extra tours can be arranged at additional cost, depending on interest

Homestay accommodation can be arranged with a family in the Amesbury School community.
